The application is only valid when returned to the ISCD secretariat prior to October 1st of the year preceding the competition and accompanied with the following documents:

1	Copy of the license(s) of the ISSF referee(s)
2	Copy of the sanction by the NPC or IOSD
3	The signed doping agreement

The organizer agrees to fulfil the conditions as stated in the ISCD rulebook 2005-2008 in Chapter 1 par. 1.3:

All MQS competitions must be sufficiently advertised (website, notification to NPC's worldwide, ...)

According the shooting program a minimum number of ISSF judges will be present during the competition:

Level	Program	ISSF judges
MQS 1	Full program: R1-R10(R9)/ P1-P5 / (FT)	3
MQS 2	Air events: R1-R5 / P1, P2, P5 /(FT)	2
MQS 3	.22 events: R6 – R8 / P3, P4	2

The ISSF referees must be approved by the ISCD. The application form must be accompanied by copy of his/her/their valid license(s).

The result book must be submitted in a paper and electronic version. The electronic version shall be the output of the MQS program submitted by ISCD for introduction of athletes in MQS competitions. (downloadable form the website)

It must include the id-numbers of the athletes in every result list.

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A minimum of 4 countries need to participate at the competition to have a valid qualification competition.
The organizer need to notify the ISCD in case this criterion will be in danger.
If this criterion is not fulfilled the participating countries need to be notified immediately after the deadline of entries.

Doping: the organizer need to sign the IPC DOPING CONTROL AGREEMENT.
For shooting competitions the number of doping tests is set to:
In case of MQS 1 a minimum of 4 doping test will be executed. The tests are spread over 2 events. The tests includes the winner and an athlete chosen at random.
In case of MQS 2 or MQS 3 a minimum of 2 doping tests will be executed. The tests are executed in one event, including the winner and an athlete at random.
In all competitions the selection of the event(s) were the tests are executed is at the discretion of the doping control body.
all necessary information will be submitted to this agency by the organizer. The organizer will confirm in writing that the ranges and targets used for the competition are conform to the relevant ISSF regulations edition 2005 and subsequent amendments.

World and/or Regional records cannot be obtained during this competition.

Mentioning MQS-competition + name and date of the competition.

Unclassified athletes (no ID-registration) will appear in the result list with blank field instead of the ID-number.
Their result (MQS) will be ratified when subsequently classified.

The ISCD will announce her decision on sanctioning the competition before the end of the year prior to the competition.
The sanction will only be valid after payment of the IPC fee and the completion of all the documents.

The doping control agreement, the sanction by the governing body (NPC /IOSD) and the copies of the licences are an integral part of the application.
